

## **Training for biologists in diagnostic microbiology (FAMH) at the Institute of Microbiology in Lausanne**

The Institute of Microbiology of the University Hospital (CHUV) of the University of Lausanne ([www.CHUV.ch/imul](http://www.CHUV.ch/imul)) offers a training position for motivated individuals with a PhD in biology. Trainees will obtain the title of specialist FAMH in diagnostic microbiology.

FMH training is a 3-year program that includes rotation activities in the various diagnostic laboratories: bacteriology, virology, mycology, parasitology, serology and molecular diagnostics, and a research activity.

The Institute of Microbiology provides a rich scientific and academic environment and it is recognized for excellence in clinical microbiology.

This degree will lead to the possibility to direct activities in an accredited diagnostic laboratory, including the capacity to develop new diagnostic tests, as well as the research profile for an academic career.

We encourage applications from candidates with a PhD in molecular biology and or bioinformatics.

The deadline for submission is January 1st, 2012, for a program starting from March 1<sup>st</sup>, or according to agreement.
